

BEST LINE AWARD 2021

- The Best Line Award is a virtual competition where participants submit a '4 best hits' video where they will be judged and ranked into finalists by an FMBA approved Judging Panel.
- The Best Line Award will be given to the top voted video by FMB World Tour fans.
- The Best Line Award is open to athletes who submitted a video for the Red Bull Rookie of the Year as well as athletes who were not contenders for the Red Bull Rookie of the Year but meet the below eligibility criteria.

Contest Timeline

- Best Line Video Submissions: May 24th, 2021 at 10:00 PST to November 30th, 2021 at 23:59 PST
- Fan Voting: Week of December 13th, 2021
- Best Line Award Recipient Notified: Week of December 20th, 2021

Award / Prizing

Best Line Award 2021

The following prizes will be awarded:

- 1st Place (Award Recipient)
 - Video featured on FMB and Crankworx social channels
 - €750,00 (EUR)
 - 2022 FMB World Tour License
- 2nd Place
 - €300,00 (EUR)
- 3rd Place
 - €200,00 (EUR)

Eligibility

- Athlete must have a current FMB World Tour License or a FMB Free Amateur License
- Athlete must not yet have competed at a Diamond event unless via Wildcard in the current 2021 season
- Athlete must be between the ages of 16 - 25 years old (as of December 31, 2021) to be eligible for participation

Rules and Regulations

Athletes need to meet the outlined eligibility criteria for participation and adhere to the Rules and Regulations.

- Disciplines: DJ & SS
- Athlete must register for the Best Line Award Contest via the FMBA member management platform. [REGISTER HERE](#)
- Videos on which athletes want to be judged on must NOT be videos from a FMBA sanctioned competition where athletes get FMB ranking pts from their regular competition results anyways
- Video runs must be a maximum length of 1min and must not contain music



- Video runs (within 1min length) should contain at least 4 consecutive tricks in one line and can contain more. '4 best hits'
- Rider Introduction must be included within the video
- Everything from the run must be seen on the video at all time - from take-off to landing - (e.g. no dead angles in landing) in order for the judges to score a run at full sight. No cuts allowed.
- Judging: the FMB approved Judging Panel will select the top 5 videos which will be open to voting by FMB World Tour fans.
- Rules & Regulations are subject to change.
